- 34.9 percent of children in Suffolk + Worcester County are food insecure.
- 65 percent of food insecure children in Suffolk and Worcester County are not eligible for federal food assistance and therefore rely on the assistance of local food pantries.
- 14.9 percent of children in Hillsborough County are food insecure.
- 46 percent of food insecure children in Hillsborough County are not eligible for federal food assistance and therefore rely on the assistance of local food pantries.

Noodles & Company is focused on the communities it serves and wants to bring attention to this issue locally. The events are being held at their locations in Burlington, Franklin, Shrewsbury, Westwood and Nashua, NH.
